



# KAIAPOI HIGH SCHOOL

## ENROLMENT SCHEME REVIEW MAY 2009

Kaiapoi High School enrolment zone was confirmed October 2007. The Ministry of Education has notified the Kaiapoi High School Board of Trustees that while the school's enrolment scheme is not due for review until 2011, it is their view that circumstances in the area have changed and that under 11PA(3) of the Education Act 1989 they require us to review the operation of the school's enrolment scheme.

Kaiapoi High School wishes to retain their existing zone established by Ministry of Education in 2007 described below, and proposes the shared area of the zone with Rangiora High School cease to exist. This would mean students in the current shared zone would be designated to attend Kaiapoi High School.

### Description of Home Zone

All students who live within the Home Zone described below shall be entitled to enrol at the school.

#### North of the Waimakariri River

Along Two Chain Rd from the Waimakariri River to South Eyre Rd. West along South Eyre Rd to Browns Rd. Along Browns Rd to Tram Rd. East along Tram Rd to Two Chain Rd. North along Two Chain Rd to Pattersons Rd. Along Pattersons Rd to Dawsons Rd. Along Dawsons Rd to Ashworths Rd. Along Ashworths Rd to intersection of Main Drain Rd and Hicklands Road. East along Hicklands Road to Easterbrook Rd. North along Easterbrook Rd to Fernside Rd. East along Fernside Rd to Lineside Rd. Across Lineside Rd to Youngs Rd. Along Youngs Rd to Camside Rd. Along Camside Rd to Waikoruru Rd. Along Waikoruru Rd to Okaihau Rd. Along Okaihau Rd to Rangiora Woodend Rd. East along Rangiora Woodend Rd to Chinnerys Rd. Along Chinnerys Rd to Main North Rd. North along Main North Rd to the south bank of the Ashley River and out to the coast.

#### South of the Waimakariri River

Start on the south side of the Waimakariri River adjacent to Two Chain Rd. Follow the River to a point in line with Dickeys Rd. South along Dickeys Rd to Main North Road. East along Main North Rd to Marshlands Rd. South along Marshlands Rd to Guthries Rd. South along Guthries Rd to Belfast Rd. East along Belfast Rd to Marshland Rd. South along Marshland Rd to Lower Styx Rd. North along Lower Styx Rd to Heyders Rd (including Old Windsor Lane and Dunlops Rd). Follow Heyders Rd to the coast, including Styx River Place.

(Please note: for all roads which form a boundary of the zone, houses on both sides of the road are included in the zone.)

The enrolment of out of zone students is governed by the provisions of the Education Act 1989. A number of out of zone students will also be accepted. Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

**First Priority** - will be given to students who have been accepted for enrolment in the special programme run by the school and approved by the Secretary for Education namely Karanga Mai Young Parents' College.

**Second Priority** - will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.

**Third Priority** - will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.

**Fourth Priority** - will be given to applicants who are children of Board employees.

**Fifth Priority** - will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status will be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.

The enrolment scheme, which includes a precise description of the home zone, may be viewed at the school office, where copies of the scheme are available.
